On a separate sheet of paper, answer these questions in a short answer form. Limit yourself to approximately 100 words. List the question before an each answer.

1. What do you expect to learn at the Ranch? List at least 5 things.
2. What skills & characteristics do you think are important for an effective teacher? Which of these skills & characteristics do you possess and how will you develop them at the Ranch?
3. Identify an important leadership training or team building strategy. How was this important to you in your life, and why would you like to pass it on to younger teen leaders?

Part 3

Along with the application answers and resume, attain 2 letters of recommendation from professors in your college's school of education or someone who has supervised or observed you in some teaching capacity.
